Report from the Director



Greetings! Trucks, trucks, trucks. Since July 16 the Art Center has been the home to an assortment of expressive and humorous truck paintings, prints and sculptures created by artist John Himmelfarb. The public response to the exhibition has been wide, enthusiastic, and joyful.

In addition to the display of Himmelfarb's work in the Art Center's T. S. Martin Atrium and the third floor Jensen, Everist and Terra Galleries, the exhibition includes an outdoor sculpture, *Penelope Awaiting Her Chamberlain*, on the south lawn of the Art Center's campus. *Penelope*, one of the artist's actual trucks turned into a sculpture, will travel to area schools to promote the exhibition in conjunction with class projects related to Himmelfarb's approach to making art.

In addition, *Penelope* will also be featured at the Art Center's ArtSplash at Riverside Park on Labor Day Weekend (see more on ArtSplash on page 8).

Also currently on view is *Sioux City Art Center Selects*, which features a new

twist on our history of juried exhibitions. The new format is designed to provide both the artist and audience a more in depth experience. Instead of including 25 – 30 artists, the show will feature only eight artists, selected from 60-plus artists that submitted work, providing each individual artist with a more adequate space to exhibit a larger body of their work.

In November *The Ritch LeGrand Collection* exhibition opens, featuring works Mr. LeGrand collected over approximately a 15- year period, and plans to donate to the Art Center. Many of the works were purchased from Art Center exhibitions, making the intended gift especially significant as both a record of the work exhibited at the Art Center, as well as reflecting the discerning eye of a dedicated collector and supporter of the Art Center.

I hope you enjoy your fall, and I look forward to seeing you at the Art Center.

Sculpt Siouxland Permanent Collection

Sculpt Siouxland

Downtown Sioux City

June 2, 2016 – June 1, 2017

In its continuing effort to make a positive impact on downtown Sioux City, Sculpt Siouxland has brought in ten new sculptures for a one-year exhibition. The Sioux City Art Center and Sculpt Siouxland work collaboratively through financial support of the Gilchrist Foundation and many local businesses. Maps of Sculpt Siouxland are available at the Art Center, Downtown Partners, and at two wayfinding stations along Fourth Street.

Visitors to the downtown are encouraged to pick up maps for an additional reason. Each map contains a ballot for the People's Choice Award. The artist who receives the most votes wins a cash prize. And one lucky voter will be randomly selected to win a prize packet from the Art Center.

CURRENT EXHIBITIONS

John Himmelfarb: Trucks

Jensen, Everist, Terra Galleries, and T. S. Martin Atrium
July 16 – October 23, 2016

Himmelfarb is one of the most respected artists of the Midwest. His work spans virtually all mediums, including painting, drawing, and printmaking, as well as sculptures in metals, ceramics, and found objects. Since 2003, he has created a large and varied series of works that focuses on trucks as the subject. In addition to this exhibition, Himmelfarb's series of truck-based artworks led to the publishing in 2014 of *John Himmelfarb: Trucks: Recent Works*, an extensive 124-page book.

In Himmelfarb's own words, "These works are not about trucks but about us, our histories, skills, coping mechanisms, ambitions and character." The Atrium contains a number of his larger sculptures, while the 3rd floor galleries present smaller sculptures and wall-mounted work. The exhibition includes an additional sculpture, which is the subject of what the Art Center has named the *Penelope Project*. The *Penelope Project* refers to one of Himmelfarb's "life-sized" truck sculptures, *Penelope Awaiting Her Chamberlain*, a 1946 Chevrolet farm truck that has been converted into a mobile sculpture. This astounding sculpture is on display on the Art Center campus and will also trek around Sioux City for visits to schools.

The Art Center is grateful to the Martin/Seamster Endowment for underwriting the Penelope Project. This project is also supported in part by an award from the National Endowment for the Arts.

Sioux City Art Center Selects

Main Gallery
August 20 – December 4, 2016

Sioux City Art Center Selects is a regional juried exhibition, open to all artists in Iowa, as well as artists living within 300 miles of Sioux City. Unlike traditional juried exhibitions that ask jurors to select individual artworks based on their merits, *Sioux City Art Center Selects* asked artists to submit a body of work, which were judged by the overall quality of the artworks and by the clarity and consistency of the body of work. The Art Center's director and curator have selected eight artists, representing Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, and South Dakota. Each of these artists has presented a cohesive group of artworks for this exhibition. The exhibition, therefore, presents visitors with a better understanding of how artists in our region are thinking and creating right now.

This exhibition has been underwritten by the Persinger Family Foundation.

Under the shade of Riverside Park's old oak trees, we celebrate 23 years and hear time and again from participants, volunteers and guests that Riverside Park is our best location ever! With the help of dedicated volunteers and sponsors, the weekend once again highlights the best of what Siouxland has to offer. 35th and Taylor, Titans of Industry, Chad Elliott, Paul Imholte, and a full line of entertainers provide two days of music and fun! Several local performers such as The Buddha Cheese Band and The Big Bad Cash Band contribute to the fantastic talent on both the Main Stage and the Children's Stage, and 400 local volunteers donate over 2,000 hours of their time. In the Children's Area, families enjoy creative activities and projects provided by eight local non-profit groups. Those that browse the juried art show rave about the selection of art available from the outstanding artists, as well as our SPLASH artists, local professional artists awarded the opportunity to experience selling art in the festival environment. With the help of a mentor artist and tents provided by the Art Center, the SPLASH artists will be ready for business at the festival this year! The many art activities in the Children's Area and Hands on for Bigger Hands booth provide cost-effective opportunities for festival-goers to exercise their own creativity, as well.

In addition to providing fun and entertainment for Siouxland locals, Art Center's ArtSplash also brings approximately \$1.5 million into Sioux City with out-of-town guests staying in hotels, buying meals, visiting local attractions and shopping.
